

ANNUAL CRICKET TRAINING PROGRAM

1. Program Highlights:

- Program will consist of 32-36 weeks of cricket between February and December. It will start from February 6th and end in November with the week of award function as the final week
- 32-36 weeks of cricket includes national and other tournaments and the practices associated with such tournaments
- Average 90 minutes of skills training and 60 minutes of Physical fitness per week
- There will be social game with coach at least once a month. Games will be played among players of similar skill level
- The program will include classes on nutrition, sports psychology and umpiring laws which will help in overall development of the players.
- The program will also cover game strategies and leadership skills to groom our players into future captains.
- Video Analysis for each player at least once
- Invite specialized coaches to hone specific skills
- Regularly assess and update skill level matrix for each player for various aspects of the game
- Keep logs of players' game data and statistics
- Annual Report on each player's progress
- Coach will have flexibility to move players from one batch to another based on skill levels keeping parents in confidence
- Access to advanced cricketing with NCCA and other regional bodies as kids advanced beyond U15 & U17

2. Program Cost:

- \$900 if you register between now and January 31st
- \$1000 after January 31st
- There is an alternate quarterly payment plan and cost will be \$400 every quarter (each quarter is a 3-month period starting February 6th).
- No extra membership fees will be charged

3. Breakdown of every dollar that is collected:

- Coach fees - \$0.40
- Infrastructure, equipment and permits - \$0.30
- Marketing and administration - \$0.10
- Tournament expenses - \$0.20

4. CCA Facilities:

- We now have permits to use Matsumoto Elementary School in Evergreen area in San Jose and Warm Springs Elementary School in Fremont to conduct coaching classes for beginners.

5. Value for Participants:

- Year round program helps coach work on various skills longer and monitor their progress.
- More games means more opportunity for the players to practice their skills
- Access to academy facilities for practices when regular training is not going on
- Participation in the national and other invitational tournaments without any cost*
- Opportunity for senior players to volunteer and get required volunteering hours for college admissions

**No tournament fees will be charged but in most cases, players have to share cost of travel, accommodation and meals.*

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6. Value for Parents:

- Year round schedule means parents can plan and schedule other activities around it
- Convenience of one-time payment
- See their child's progress continuously and regularly

7. Expectations from Parents:

- 50% of the fees should be paid with matching fund from your company if your company supports non-profit organizations.
- Volunteer your time during social games and tournaments whenever requested.
- Snacks, drinks duty
- Help spread the word about CCA's annual program.

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10. Changes, Cancellations & Refunds:

- Full refund (-\$20 for processing fees) if membership is cancelled by February 15th.
- 50% refund if cancelled between February 15th & March 15th.
- No refund after March 15th.
- First time CCA enrollees can sign up for quarterly program and convert it to annual program membership by paying the remaining amount before end of the quarter.
