



2016 ANNUAL PROGRAM OUTLINE

1. Program Highlights:

- Program will consist of 30 weeks of supervised cricket from March to November. 30 weeks of cricket includes national, internal and other tournaments and the practices associated with such tournaments
- Average 90 minutes of skills training. Additional 60 minutes of fitness per week.
- Practice games and social games supervised by the coach. Games will be played among players of similar skill level.
- The program will prepare players to handle challenges associated with competitive games.
- The program will also cover game strategies and leadership skills to groom our players to be valuable team player.
- Invite specialized coaches to hone specific skills.
- Regularly assess and update skill level matrix for each player for various aspects of the game.
- Classroom sessions to reinforce in fundamentals of the game through videos and discussions.
- Keep logs of players' game data and statistics
- Annual Report on each player's progress - Either in person or in writing.
- Coach will have flexibility to move players from one batch to another based on skill levels keeping parents in confidence
- Access to adult cricketing with NCCA, BACA, Super 25 and other regional bodies as players advance beyond U15 & U17
- Eligible to participate in the international and domestic tours
- One free set of CCA outfit
- CCA nets available for extra practice when CCA organized training sessions are not going on
- Senior players may get opportunity to do paid internship with CCA partner schools
- Player and immediate family members will be invited to the Annual function **free of charge**.

2. Program Cost:

- \$950 if you register between now and February 28th.
- \$1050 after February 28th.
- Alternate payment plan may be available upon request.
- No extra membership fees will be charged

3. Breakdown of every dollar that is collected:

- Coach fees - \$0.40
- Infrastructure, equipment and permits - \$0.30
- Marketing and administration - \$0.10
- Tournament and game expenses - \$0.20

**No tournament fees will be charged but in most cases, players will have to share cost of travel, accommodation and meals for themselves and coach.*
