Coaching Program Details

- Dates – March thru November
- Cost - \$1000
- 25% Sibling discount; 25% discount for girls
- Online registration
- One-on-one package - \$200 for 5 sessions , 1 hr each with coach Rakesh
- One on One Package - \$60 for 1 session(1 hr) with coach Amit, Bimal,Mukund or Prasanth.
- Wicket-keeping – Regular classes
- Team practices may supersede fitness

Our informal survey shows that we play more games than any other academy in the world - Players played anywhere from 30 to 60 games in 2017

Tournaments & Tours:

- Year round tournaments with clear objectives
 - Win (Team A) and Compete (Team B)
- Selection process :
 - Coaches consult among themselves to select from progress made in nets and game performances.
 - Special Selection nets not always necessary.
 - Team Balance (role based) inevitable for victory – dynamic nature of selection
 - Captain selection by coach. Rotation not guaranteed.
- CCA membership is mandatory to participate.



Funding for tours

- Participating players pay for their own Travel, Lodging, boarding
- Local tour coach expense by CCA
- International tour coach expense by members of the Team

*In 2016 CCA spent in excess of \$9K in coach

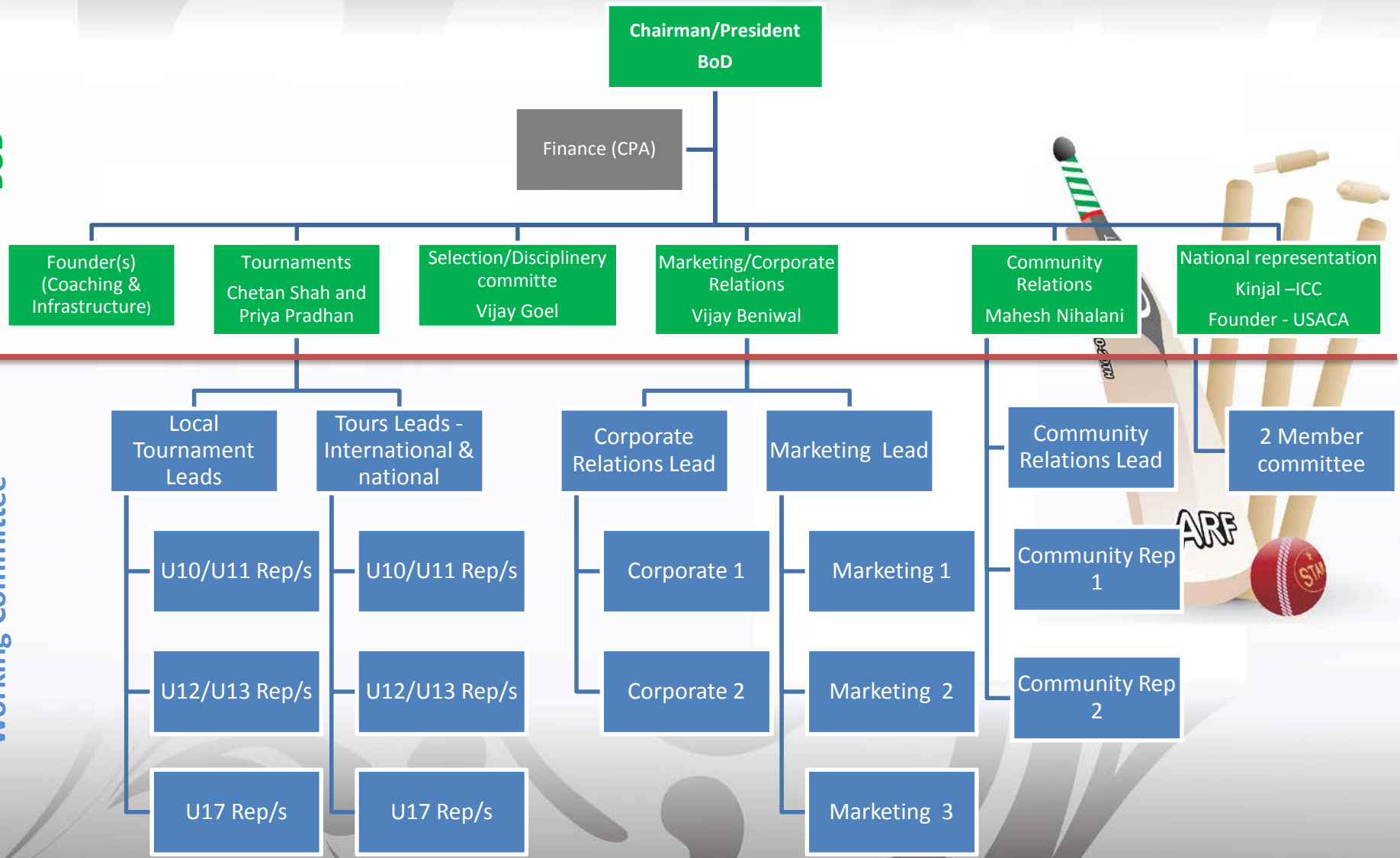

Roles

- Local Tournament Leads
 - Tournament Identification and Registration on time
 - Help Identify Team managers
 - Initial contact with tournament organizer
 - Participate in cross tournament team meetings
 - Identify Potential umpire candidates for training
 - Identify potential scoring candidates and schedule training
 - Recruit pool of volunteers for different tasks
 - Ensure selection committee selects teams on a timely basis



Roles

- Tournament Leads International
 - Tour related documents requirements
 - Tour Practice Games off shore
 - Tour strategy of number of players
 - Practice plans locally
 - Identify Manager
 - Identify pool of Volunteers for various tasks



BOD

- BOD Nominated by founders
- BOD meets at least Every other month Rain or Shine
- Working committees –To meet at least once every month (more frequently if there are tournaments)
- Working committee term - March thru February with Feb as transition month
- Feedback, review and actions- respond back to parents every 3 months – publicize the actions done based on feedback
